2. November Meeting Review:
  - a. Attendance:
    - i. 28 students with perfect attendance for all of Term 1 & 2 will receive a candy bar.
    - ii. 49 students will receive a pencil for perfect 2nd term attendance.
    - iii. Term 1 810 Tardies + Term 2 820 = 1,630 year total
    - iv. Absences Term 1 940 + Term 2 1091 = Total 2031
    - v. Mrs. Taylor had fewest tardies and Mrs. McFerren fewest absences
    - vi. A letter went home at SEPs for students with multiple tardies and absences.
  - b. Leadership teams have started!
    - i. Janie Raff asked about how we are doing compared with other LIM schools in rolling out the leadership teams. She mentioned that there are students still unsure of whether or not they will be selected for a team. Mr. Nowell spoke to the topic and explained how we brought out the team applications a little too ambitiously and had to slow down. We hope to have all of the teams in place and running by our Leadership Day on March 1st.
  - c. Leadership Day is March 1st. We will be presenting a program to educate the audience about The Leader in Me and The 7 Habits.
  - d. Grants - Beginning in March, we can submit for The Global Impact Team at Ebay Spring grant monies. We can also submit for a Walmart grant around this same time. Betsy Eckton has been recruited to help write the grants. Mrs. Kidd is interested in helping as well.
  - e. Title 1 monies differential. As a council, it was decided that a cut in monies would come from the technology budget so long as we could still purchase needed devices. We were able to purchase 7 Chromebooks even with an amount reduction. 3rd-6th all have one to one Chromebooks. Next year, our focus will shift to the younger grades and their device needs. Mr. Nowell expressed an interest in Chromebooks as opposed to iPads due to lower cost and better function for MyOn.

  - a. Overall budget projections - We are the #2 Title 1 School for 2018-2019. We will know some time in March what are funding will look like for the coming year.
