1. Welcome
2. January Meeting Review:
 - a. Leadership Day is March 1st. We will be presenting a program to educate the audience about The Leader in Me and The 7 Habits. - Mr. Nowell & Mrs. Samuels Invitations distributed to the SCC members.  - b. Grants - Beginning in March, we can submit for The Global Impact Team at Ebay Spring grant monies. We can also submit for a Walmart grant around this same time. Once the Ebay Grant opens, we will apply. The Walmart Grant is online. Mrs. Samuels is willing to submit for that grant for the school. We will also speak with Betsy Eckton about other grant options. She is a lady in the know.
 - c. March Meeting Date Change. Our next meeting is scheduled for March 23rd. Our signed Trustlands Plan is due that day. We need to meet earlier so that we can finalize the plans and get all necessary signatures. March 14th at 9:30 appears to be a good day for those in attendance at today's meeting. 3. Technology:
 - a. \$8,500 Grant from the District for Technology - Mr. Rawlings For the past few years, our focus has been to get technology for our upper grades. Since we have accomplished this goal, we can now focus on the lower grades.
 - i. Kinder is good.
 - ii. 1st grade: iPads (district cost \$300) Approx. 13.
 - iii. 2nd grade: Chromebooks (district cost \$205) Approx. 22
 - iv. The total is \$8,419.
 - v. We are getting a \$50 Chromebook cart from Wyoming.
4. Trustlands Plan
 - a. \$43,988.64: Plan from this amount for now. There is a potential for a 3% increase to \$45,308.30. Mr. Rawlings proposed that we take monies from the technology

and professional development sections to help cover the costs for our technicians.
We discussed the pros and cons of changing those amounts.
