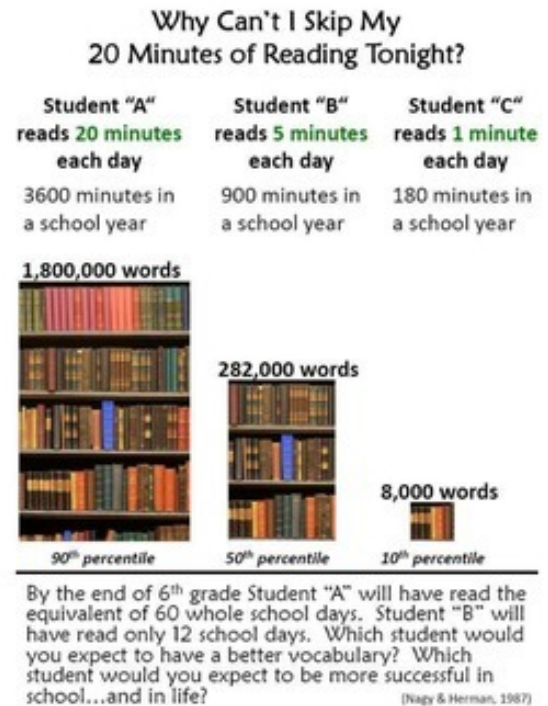

Welcome Back! There is nothing better than students, teachers, and our Wilson community busy in our school. We are excited for year two as a Leader in Me School. We spent year one focusing on the *7 Habits of Happy Kids*. This year, we get to work on Wildly Important Goals (WIGs). DROP-OFF AND PICK-UP
