1. **Welcome: (Mr. Rawlings)**
 - Asked what everyone was up to and welcomed everyone to the meeting.
2. **September Meeting Review:**
 - Still recruiting members, had a new application from Emily Wright
 - All in favor of Emily Wright, Amy and Jessica in favor
 - 280 Students were in attendance last month, now we have 279
3. **Digital Citizenship Week**
 - **Look at Daily Focus**
 - Carli Wright put together
 - Discussed what will be happening and looked over handout
 1. Monday: Healthy balance with media usage/Digital Citizen Head to Toe
 2. Tuesday: Privacy and Safety/Power to be safe with technology
 3. Wednesday: Kind, appropriate communication/Wilson Lions are friends and Leaders wear green
 4. Thursday: Critical Thinking/I am not afraid to use my head with technology... wear Halloween Costume
 - Discussed Halloween Parade and what that will look like for our school with COVID procedures
4. **School Safety:**
 - **Stop Sign:** Update is the two way stop now became a 4 way stop (this has been something we have been looking forward to)
 - **Yield Sign:** Over by preschool there is a Yield sign going North/South which hasn't been there in the past
 - Mayor Wright has been helping to get these items installed
 - What do you think about there needing to be a crosswalk person on the 4 stop? Asked parents thoughts and what they would like.
 - Amy mentioned that kids may not know when it is okay to cross
 - Jessica mentioned we have younger kids that can benefit from having someone there and to help them
 - Amy asked about Kindergarten pull thru area and students/parents being able to cross (Shawn will follow up and see what the protocol is for that)
5. **Technology Update**
 - **Smartboards:** 3 year subscription was purchased for the teachers with the Smartboard and that subscription was purchased from Title One funds
 - Tiffany shared her experience with the Smartboard and how it is being used
 - **Chromebooks:** 1 to 1 in 2nd-5th grade, working towards getting touch chromebooks for 1 to 1 in Kindergarten and 1st grade (order is looking like we won't have anything before the end of the calendar year)

- Would like to have that available in 1st grade and Kindergarten
- Invited members to think about funding and if we could look at getting more touch chromebooks with the funds
- Talked about the chromebooks we may need to cycle out
- Lost about 20 during the school shut down in the spring, district will be replacing those that didn't come back or were damaged
- Purchased 11 chromebook carts for \$1000, Mrs. Haskell was able to help get those and we are so grateful for that

6. Remote Learning vs At School Learning

- Discussed 15 students returning from Remote Learning and then 1 student will be going from At School Learning to Remote Learning

7. Trustlands Funding for 2020-2021

- Had previously reported a different number last month, we have current numbers based on the update
- Hopefully next month we will be able to map that out more specifically and see where those changes took place
- SCC will help decide how we should spend that money
- We will review data and changes from last year
- Other funds: technicians to attend opening faculty meeting, etc.
